 - 1 Samuel 18:28–29 When Saul realized that the LORD was with David ... he remained his enemy the rest of his days.
- Saul's insecurity is root of his hostility
 - 1 Samuel 18:8-9 "They have credited David with tens of thousands," he thought, "but me with only thousands. What more can he get but the kingdom?" And from that time on Saul kept a jealous eye on David.

WHEN GOD MAKES HIMSELF KNOWN

- John 18:6 When Jesus said, "I am he," they drew back and fell to the ground.
- Revelation 1:17 When I saw him, I fell at his feet as though dead. Then he placed his right hand on me and said: "Do not be afraid. I am the First and the Last.
- Matthew 17:5-6 While he was still speaking, a bright cloud enveloped them, and a voice from the cloud said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased. Listen to him!" When the disciples heard this, they fell facedown to the ground, terrified.
- Ezekiel 1:28 This was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the LORD. When I saw it, I fell facedown, and I heard the voice of one speaking.

WE LIVE OUT OF OUR HEART

- Proverbs 4:23 Above all else, guard your heart, for it is the wellspring of life.
- Matthew 12:34-35 For out of the overflow of the heart the mouth speaks. The good man brings good things out of the good stored up in him, and the evil man brings evil things out of the evil stored up in him.
- Mark 7:18-23 Don't you see that nothing that enters a man from the outside can make him 'unclean'? For it doesn't go into his heart but into his stomach, and then out of his body... He went on: What comes out of a man is what makes him 'unclean.' For from within, out of men's hearts, come evil thoughts, sexual immorality, theft, murder, adultery, greed, malice, deceit, lewdness, envy, slander, arrogance and folly. All these evils come from inside and make a man 'unclean.'
