#### COVENANT REAFFIRMED

- Kindness- not 'nice-ness,' but love, loyalty, mercy, and goodness
- **David to Jonathan:** As for you, show kindness to your servant, for you have brought him into a covenant with you before the LORD. If I am guilty, then kill me yourself! Why hand me over to your father?"
- Jonathan to David: But show me unfailing kindness like the LORD's kindness as long as I live, so that I may not be killed, and do not ever cut off your kindness from my family

#### JONATHAN'S CHARACTER

### Deep trust in God resulting in courageous acts for God-

- Perhaps the LORD will act in our behalf. Nothing can hinder the LORD from saving, whether by many or by few.
- We will cross over toward them and let them see us.
- If they say, 'Come up to us,' we will climb up because that will be our sign that the LORD has given them into our hands.

## DON'T WORRY, GOD IS GOOD




Matthew 7.11: If you, then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him!
