- Luke 12.47-48: "The servant who knows the master's will and does not get ready or does not do what the master wants will be beaten with many blows. But the one who does not know and does things deserving punishment will be beaten with few blows. From everyone who has been given much, much will be demanded; and from the one who has been entrusted with much, much more will be asked.
- Romans 1.20: For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature—have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that people are without excuse.

OUR BATTLE/ENEMY/WEAPONS ARE SPIRITUAL

- Ephesians 6:10-13- Finally, be strong in the Lord and in His mighty power. Put on the full armor of God so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand.
- 2 Corinthians 10:4- The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world.


IDENTIFY YOUR ENEMY

- **He looks really good.** Satan himself masquerades as an angel of light. (2 Corinthians 11:14)






USE WEAPONS GOD HAS PROVIDED
