We have the honor of partnering with Foster4Love once again to help organize our annual Secret Santa program. Foster4Love is an amazing non-profit focused on providing medical services, training opportunities, local events and support services for foster children and parents. We currently have close to 550 children in foster care in Cobb County. Each of our foster children will submit a Christmas Wish List and we will diligently track each item to ensure each gift is given to the correct child. Please join us this year to help provide a little cheer to our foster children. You can play your part in Secret Santa by purchasing one or more gifts from a foster child's wish list.

Below is a little more information on the general cost of gifts/wish list for our children:

1 gift for a younger child	\$25
1 gift for an older child	\$40
Wish list for child aged 0-3 years	\$60
Wish list for child aged 4-9 years	\$85
Wish list for child aged 10-12 years	\$105
Wish list for child aged 13 and older	\$135

registration form and return to me directly at Cobb County DFCS. With close to 550 children in care we spend a lot of time planning, preparing, and organizing for our Secret Santa program. We will start accepting gifts dropped off at a specific location between November 18th and December 6th. We will provide more information about drop off times and locations as the time comes.
