## Activity

### All the Feels

#### What You Need

Paper plates or plain paper and a marker

#### What You Do

Draw four different faces on plates or paper. Or print the attached page. Draw or color the happy face, sad face, angry face, and scared face. Show each of the faces to your family and have everyone practice making the face. Then, turn the faces over and shuffle them. Let each person have a chance to choose a face and make that face while the rest of the family guesses which face they are making. Play it again!

#### What You Say

"Let's look at these different faces I drew. There's a happy face. Let's all make a happy face. This one is a sad face. Can you make a sad face? Oh my! This one is an angry face. Show me your angry face. This one is a scared face. Let's all be scared together. Great job."



"Now, you choose a plate. Do not show your face to anyone. You can only show it to me if you need help. When you see the face on your plate, you will make the same face. We will try to guess what you're feeling. Okay, let's play!"

"That was super fun! Tell me, can we talk to God when we're happy? How about when we're sad? Or angry? Or scared? Yes! We can talk to God anytime, anywhere, about anything! God wants to talk to you because He made you."

**Who made you? God made me."**

## Prayer

"Dear God, it's such a big idea to think that the God who made everything wants to hear from people, but it's true. You really do want us to talk to You. And because You are God, You can hear us talk to You anytime, anywhere, about anything! That is so awesome! Thank You for loving us like You do, God. We love You. In Jesus' name, amen."

## BASIC TRUTH

God made me.

## 1. LOOK AT YOU

**WHAT YOU NEED:** child safe mirrors

**WHAT YOU DO:** Sit with your child and look in mirrors. Have them point to different parts of their bodies. Continue as long as there is interest.

**WHAT YOU SAY:** "Look at these mirrors. Let's look at ourselves in them. Can you point to your legs? Great job! God made your legs. Can you point to your arm? Great job! God made your arms. *(Continue with additional instructions.)* The Bible teaches us that God made you and me and everyone."

## 2. WONDERFULLY MADE

**WHAT YOU DO:** Sit together with your child and ask them to wiggle their ears. Say "God made your ears." Ask them to shake their arms. Say "God made your arm." Ask them to jump up and down. Say "God made your legs to jump up and down." Continue as long as there is interest.

**WHAT YOU SAY:** "Come and sit with me. God made you so special! Show me how you wiggle your ears. God made your ears.

Show me how you shake your arm. God made your arm. Show me how you jump up and down. God made your legs. Show me how you blink your eyes. God made your eyes. Show me how you clap your hands. God made your hands. You are special because God made you."

## 3. GOD MADE

**WHAT YOU DO:** Speak or sing (with mask on) the following to the tune of "Where is Thumbkin?"

*Song Lyrics-Post over changing table or in your child's bedroom!*

"Yes, He did.

"I'm so glad that God made you!"

## 4. STACK THE BLOCKS

**WHAT YOU NEED:** blocks

**WHAT YOU DO:** Gather your child to play with blocks. Stack them up! Each time they put a block on the stack, say a word from the phrase, "God made you." Continue as long as there is interest.

**WHAT YOU SAY:** "Let's play with this toy together. Can you stack a block? God. Can you stack another block? Loves. Can you stack another block? You. Good job! God made you. Yeah, God made you! *(Clap.)* Let's knock over our tower and do it again."
