TODDLER ACTIVITIES

1. PUZZLE TIME

WHAT YOU NEED: Crawler puzzles with knobs

WHAT YOU DO: Sit with your child and work on puzzles together. Talk often about how you need a plan to do a puzzle. Continue as long as there is interest.

WHAT YOU SAY: "We have some fun puzzles to do today. I love puzzles because there is always a plan! First you take out the pieces. Then you look at the shapes. Then you put the pieces back. It's a great plan. Do you know who always has a plan for you? God. God loves you and has a plan for you."

2. COLOR PLAN

WHAT YOU DO: Various colors of construction paper

WHAT YOU DO: Place the construction paper around the room on the floor. Instruct your child to walk from one color to the next based on the plan. Continue as long as there is interest.

WHAT YOU SAY: "Let's play a fun game. When I say a color, I want you to walk to that color paper. Are you ready? Here's the plan. Walk to the red paper. Great job! You followed the plan. Now I have a new plan. Walk to the blue paper. Wow! You did it. You followed the plan. Did you know that God has a plan for you? He does! God loves you and has a plan for you."

3. GOD HAS A PLAN

WHAT YOU DO: Sing the song below to the tune of "Mary Had a Little Lamb."

WHAT YOU SAY: "I have a fun song to sing together."

"God has a plan for you and me, you and me, you and me.

"God has a plan for you and me; just you wait and see.

"I'm so glad God has a plan for you and for me."

4. STACKING PLAN


WHAT YOU NEED: Ring Stacker

WHAT YOU SAY: "Let's play with the ring stacker. We need a plan to work it. What's our plan? I think we should do the biggest to the smallest circle. Can you find the biggest circle and put it on first? Now, I think we need to put the next biggest circle. That's a good plan. Keep going until we have the smallest circle on the top. We had to make a plan to do the ring stacker. Did you know God has a plan for you? He does. God loves you, and God has a plan for you."





Do This



Morning Time

When you go into your child’s room, say, “Good morning! I see someone God loves, and (his, her) name is . . . (say your child’s name as you pick them up or tickle their tummy).”



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child this month and pray, “Dear God, thank You that Your plan was for us to be a family. Thank You for (name the people in your immediate family). Help us to be kind to one another. We love You, God. In Jesus’ name. Amen.”



Drive Time

As you drive or take a walk, say to your child, “Do you remember how Joseph was a helper in the Bible story? Let’s look for helpers outside. If you see someone helping, say, ‘helper!’”



Bath Time

Add a plastic bowl and a measuring cup to bath time. Tell your child to use the measuring cup to scoop and pour the water into the bowl, like Joseph scooped and poured the grain.

Just like learning to walk, talk, self-feed, and potty-train, preschoolers can learn the skill of making and keeping friends.


