### Activity

#### Traveling Memory Verse

#### What You Need

Paper plates

#### What You Do

Review the memory verse with your child using the motions once. Give them a paper plate and demonstrate how to hold the plate in front of you like a steering wheel. "Drive" around your home as you repeat the memory verse together.

#### What You Say

"We're learning an awesome verse from the Bible this month to remind us that God loves me and that God's got it. Let's say it with our motions, too.


"God (*point both hands straight up*)  
is with you (*point out to a friend*)  
wherever (*wave hands in a circle*)  
you go, (*march in place*)  
Joshua 1:9." (*Open your hands like a book.*)

"Is God with us at home? Yes! Is God with us when we travel? Of course! I have these steering wheels here. I want you to hold your steering wheel up like this (*demonstrate*), and we'll drive around as we say the verse together. Let's get in a line and drive together so our cars don't bump into each other. We don't want to have any car crashes!

"That was a fun drive! Let's park our cars by having a seat right where you are. I'm so glad for this important truth that 'God is with you wherever you go!' Knowing this helps me remember that God's got it.  
**Who's got it? God's got it.**"

### Prayer

"Dear God, You take care of each of us in so many ways. You are with us wherever we go. We should never worry, because no matter what, You've got it. Thank You for loving us so much. In Jesus' name, amen."

## GOT IT ACTIVITY:

**WHAT YOU DO:** Large ball

**WHAT YOU DO:** Sit with your child on the floor and roll the ball back and forth. Continue as long as there is interest. Say, "You got it," often. End with, "God's got it."

**WHAT YOU SAY:** "Come and play with this awesome ball with me. I'm going to roll it to you. You got it! Great job! Okay, now I'm going to roll it to another friend. You got it! Wow! You all did a great job catching that ball. You got it most of the time. Do you know who's got it all the time? God. God loves you and is always with you. God's got it."

## YES, HE DOES! ACTIVITY:

**WHAT YOU DO:** Sing the following with your child to the tune of, "If You're Happy and You Know It."

What You Say: "Come and sing a song with me."

*(Singing)*

## WHOS GOT IT?

**WHAT YOU NEED:** Three plush animals; a small plastic ball

**WHAT YOU DO:** Sit with your child and put three plush animals in front of you. Have your child cover their eyes then hide the ball under one of the animals. Ask your child to uncover their eyes and ask who's got the ball? Name the animal that got it. Continue as long as there is interest.

**WHAT YOU SAY:** "Look at our toy animal friends. We have a *(name plush)*, a *(name plush)*, and a *(name plush)*. I'm going to hide this ball under one of them, so close your eyes. Open your eyes. Who's got the ball? Who's got it? The *(name animal)*'s got it! Let's do it again! Close your eyes. Okay, open them! Who's got it? The *(name animal)*'s got it! Do you know who's always got it? God. God loves you and will always be with you. God's got it."
