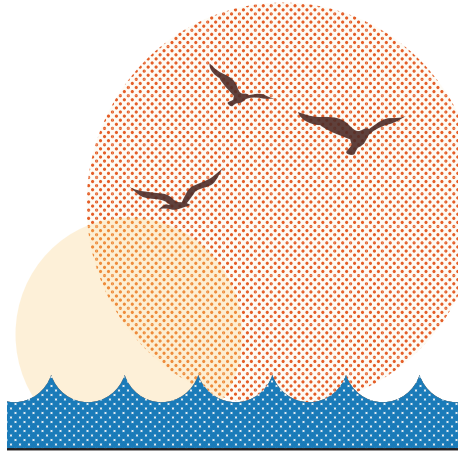

### Bed Time

When someone or something makes you mad, it is so easy to say or do the first thing that comes to mind. It takes a lot more strength to bite your tongue and choose not to fight. Sometimes it even helps to actually walk away so that you don't say or do something you'll regret later. Pray that God will show you, this week, when to care about others by walking away from a fight.



## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- How do you know when you should walk away and let an argument end?
- How can you peacefully disagree with someone? (*This allows for the discussion that we can disagree with people and still care about them. It is when winning the argument is more important than caring for the person that the disagreement become “un-peaceful”.*)
- Do you think anybody you know doesn't believe in God?
- What are ways we can act that show people we believe in and follow Jesus?
- When we do our best to follow God and be an example of what that means, what are we hoping for? (*many possible answers for this one, but really looking for things like: people ask us questions about our faith, people know that Christians love other people, etc.*)

Sometimes it is easy to forget that you can win an argument but lose the heart in the process.
