Activity

Jump In!

What You Need

Blue bed sheet or towel

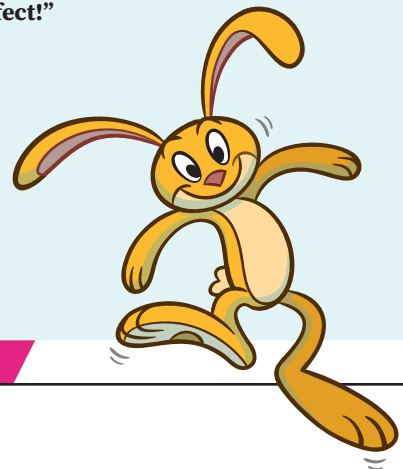
What You Do

Spread the blue sheet/towel out on the floor. Encourage your kid to jump in the "water" seven times as you review the Bible story. Repeat as long as there is interest.

Say, "In our Bible story, Naaman was sick. He had boo-boos all over his skin. He asked a man who loved God if God would help make his boo-boos better. The man told Naaman that God would help him. All he had to do was wash in the water seven times.

"It was hard for Naaman, but he decided to JUMP, JUMP, and go God's way. Let's pretend we are Naaman, and this is water. Let's jump in this water seven times. Ready? (*Jump in and out each time you count.*) ONE! TWO! THREE! FOUR! FIVE! SIX! SEVEN!

"Naaman went God's way, and God made his boo-boos all better! Yay! Naaman was so glad he trusted that God's way is perfect. **Whose way is perfect? God's way is perfect!**"



Prayer

Dear God, we want to JUMP, JUMP, and go Your way, but sometimes it's hard. Please help go Your way even when it's hard. We know Your way is perfect, and it is always best to JUMP, JUMP, and go Your way. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen.

Naaman Retelling Story Craft

1. Print
2. Color adding red marks to show skin disease on one side only.
3. Cut on dotted line
4. Fold Naaman picture in half on solid line.
5. Tape a straw inside folded pictures.
6. Twirl picture back and forth while counting.

Hello, Parents!

This month, we're learning that God's way is perfect. Today, we heard the story of Naaman. We can make a spinning Naaman to help us retell the story. To play with it, hold the straw between your hands then rub them back and forth like you would to warm them. Count to seven as you twirl it back and forth so the spots disappear. Sometimes following God's way is hard, but we have to remember that God's way is perfect.
