

• The crowds – come to Jesus because of what He can do for them; not bad but not sufficient

 The disciples – following Jesus; committed to learning from Him and living like Him

• The apostles (The Twelve) – chosen by Jesus to be with Him in deeper way and commissioned by Him to do His ministry • **Blasphemy** – to slander or defame God

## ETERNAL/ UNFORGIVABLE SIN

**Blasphemy against the Holy Spirit** – to attribute the Holy Spirit's work through Jesus to the devil (He has an impure spirit)

 Why unforgiveable? – it is never acknowledged as sin and never repented of

## ETERNAL/ UNFORGIVABLE SIN

• **Can't accidentally commit this sin** – it is a persistent rejection of the convicting and enlightening work of the Holy Spirit

- God is for reconciliation He is not looking for reasons to keep people out but opportunities to draw them in
  - Father forgive them
  - Paul I once was a blasphemer and persecutor (1Tim 1.13)

## WORK OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

- We don't blaspheme, but we do become cynical:
  - God has disappointed us in the past
  - God doesn't fully explain Himself
  - People who trust God fully seem naïve
- **Remedy** regular and intentional thankfulness; acknowledging God-atwork will help keep your eyes open to His activity in your life



- We don't try to seize Jesus, but we do try to manage Him through:
  - Good behavior
  - Spiritual disciplines especially prayer and fasting
- **Remedy –** regular and intentional submission to Him
  - Act of saying, 'I surrender, I submit' will change your heart over time
  - Submission often looks like obedience
