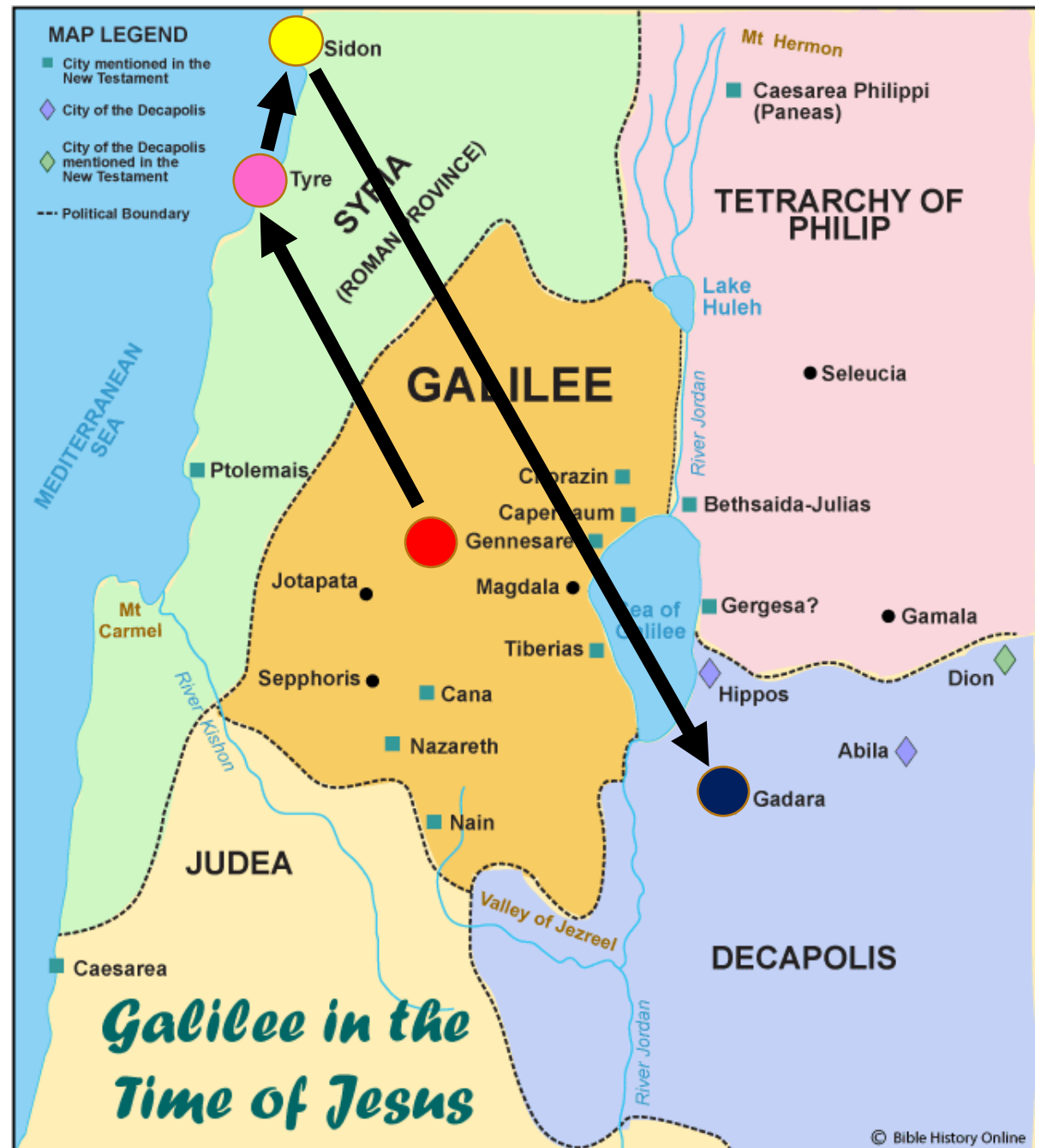

Can we say, 'Jesus does all things well?'

- **Well** - beautifully, fitly, appropriately, in the right way; most often designates the suitability or appropriateness of an action or a state of affairs
- **Easier** for some to say, 'God is good,' than, 'God does all things well'
- **Prayer point** - help me to see this as true

Can we say, 'God satisfies my desires?'

- **Psalm 103.5** - God satisfies our desires with good things
- **Can you name your desires?** If we don't name them, we will never bring them to Jesus
- **Jesus' Garden Prayer**
 - **Statement of desire** - Father, everything is possible for You. Take this cup from Me
 - **Posture of submission** - Yet not what I will, but what You will
 - Impossible prayer if we don't

Do we remember?

- **To remember** - not simply to recall facts from the past, but to recall the past and to then live in the present in light of that recollection
- **Do we remember the truths of who God is?**
- **Do we remember our testimony (how God has acted in our lives)?**
- **Do we remember what God says about His Kingdom?**
