Sunday - Triumphal Entry

- Deliberate, but subtle claim to kingship
- **Zechariah 9.9:** Rejoice greatly, Daughter Zion! Shout, Daughter Jerusalem! See, **your king comes to you, righteous and victorious, lowly and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey.**

MARK 11.20-12.12

Parable of the Tenants

- Owner = God
- Farmers = Religious leaders
- Servants = God's messengers (prophets) sent to God's people
- Son = Jesus

Cornerstone – 1st stone laid in a foundation that all other stones are aligned to; most important stone in a building

Fruit

- **Character** – what the Holy Spirit produces in us
 - **Gal 5.22-23** – love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, gentleness, faithfulness, self-control
- **Results of our work** – what the Holy Spirit produces through us (our words, actions, efforts)
 - **Col 1.10** – may you bear fruit in every good work

Prayer

- **Forgiveness** – we either live in the eco-system of mercy or the eco-system of judgment
- **Matt 18.21-35** – Parable of the Unmerciful Servant

Prayer

- **Faith** – trust in the goodness of God (willingness to act) and greatness of God (ability to act)
- Mt 17.20 – if you have faith the size of a mustard seed you can move mountains
