- To **G**entile churches in modern-day Turkey experiencing persecution
- **F**ocus on how to live faithfully in difficult circumstances

Three words about our identity as followers of Jesus

- **Elect** - chosen; selected for a purpose
- **Exiles** - pilgrims, sojourners; temporary residents in a foreign land
- **Scattered** - dispersed

I PETER
1:1-2

Three phrases describing **Elect Exiles**

Chosen according to the foreknowledge of **God** -

- **Foreknowledge** - knowing in advance often w/sense of working out **God's** prior plan and purpose
- **We** are **Elect Exiles** because of **God's** plan and purpose. **Our** scattering is not accidental or incidental, but intentional and essential.

Three phrases describing **Elect Exiles**
Through the sanctifying work of the **Spirit -**

- **Sanctification** - process of becoming holy
- **Initially at conversion** - we are washed clean of our sin
- **Ongoing** - we are conformed more and more into the image of **Jesus**
- **We** become part of the **Elect Exiles** both through the initial cleansing of

Three phrases describing **Elect Exiles**

To be obedient to the word of **Christ**
and sprinkled by **His** blood

- **Background - Ex 24.3-8**
- **Pattern of covenant making -**
 - **God** delivers a people
 - **God** invites people into relationship
- **He** will be their **God**/they will be
His people
 - **Covenant** is ratified w/blood
- **We** are **Elected** to live in covenantal
relationship w/**God**; to be **His** people
is to be **Elected Exiles** in this world.
