- Submit to authority voluntarily yield out of reverence for God as long as obedience to human authorities doesn't lead to disobeying God


## WIVES

- Same principle submit (to voluntary yield to; to obey) to husbands
- Same limitations disobey husband if obedience to him results in disobedience to God; 'don't give way to fear'
- Same foundation fear of God; 'reverence of your lives'
- Same aim to win husbands to Jesus through their Godly behavior; 'see (observe)

## HUSBANDS


- Be considerate according to knowledge; allow what you know about your wife to inform how you live with her
- Treat with respect show honor
- Why?
  - Physically weaker more vulnerable, so don't intimidate
  - Equal before God 'heirs with you'
  - Maintain healthy relationship with God 'so






Roman Empire when Peter is writing


- Total Population 50mil

- Christians 0.1% of population; (1 in 1000)





Roman Empire 300 years later

- Total Population 60mil
- Total Number of Christians 32mil
- Christians 52% of population
