

Elect - chosen, selected, picked up; speaks to **G**od's care/concern for us

• As Elect - God has given us new birth into a living hope and into an inheritance that never perishes, spoils, or fades

Exiles - temporary residents in a foreign land; speaks to our relationship to the community in which we live

• As Exiles - expect to suffer as a byproduct of following Jesus



Three commands

- Don't be surprised at your suffering, it is nothing strange (and can actually be used by God for your good)
- Rejoice inasmuch as (to the degree that) you participate in the sufferings of Jesus
- Commit yourself to your faithful Creator and continue to do good

Suffering - a fiery ordeal

word

- **Refiner's fire -** brings impurities to surface
- Test opportunity to see genuineness/quality of one's faith
- 1 Peter 1.6-7 trials = tests, same

Rejoice inasmuch as you participate in sufferings of Jesus-

• **Rejoice-** to be in a state of gladness, happiness, or well-being

• Two examples:

- If you are insulted b/c of name of Jesus, you are blessed (a privileged recipient of divine favor) b/c the Holy Spirit lives in you
- If you suffer as a follower of

Commit yourself to your faithful Creator and continue to do good

- Suffering according to God's will
 experiencing persecution as a byproduct of following Jesus
- **Commit -** entrust yourself to **G**od with confidence that **H**e can preserve you

Tests in the **B**ible

Set up by God

- Abraham Gen 22; will Abraham sacrifice Isaac, the son of promise?
- Manna Ex 16.4/Deut 8.16; will
 Israelites trust God for *daily* bread?

Allowed by God/results of fallen world

- False prophets Deut 13.3; will Israel remain true to the Lord if someone performing miracles tries to lead them towards other gods?
- Nations Jud 2.22; will Israel 'keep the way of the Lord' or follow the gods of the nations/their neighbors?
