Are We Justified ?

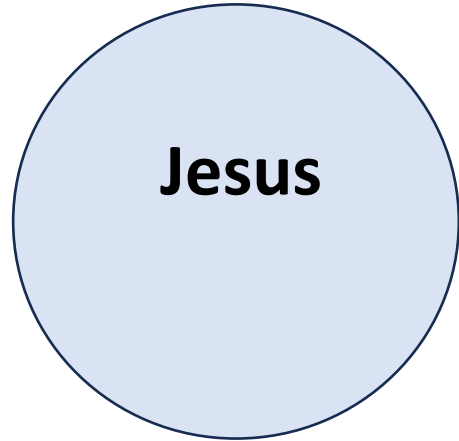
- **Through faith in Jesus** – trust, commitment, allegiance

- **Through the Law** – 613 commandments given to Moses
 - **Old Covenant** – terms of agreement between God and Israel



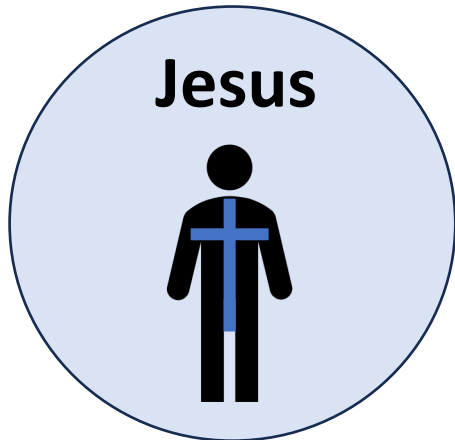
