Paul appealing to Galatians to return to the Gospel – justification through faith in Jesus

- Appeal to personal experience they believed Gospel and were justified; Holy Spirit is evidence
- Appeal to Abraham
 - he was justified through faith
 - Gospel of justification through faith was given to him
- Appeal to nature of the Law
 - Law is rooted in effort vs faith
 - Attempting to be justified through the Law leads to rejection by God
- Appeal to the Cross Jesus died to redeem us from the curse of the Law



Promises Made to Abraham

- Gen 12. 1-3, 7: Go from your country, your people and your father's household to the land I will show you.
- I will make you into a great nation, and I will bless you;
- I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing.
- I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse;
- And all peoples on earth (Gentiles) will be blessed (accepted by God/justified) through you (through faith just as you were.)
- To your offspring (seed) I will give this land.



Abraham	Jesus
I will make you into a great nation, and I will bless you	Jesus is the Head of the Church, the New Israel
I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing	Jesus is the Name above all names
I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse	Jesus is the only way to the Father
all peoples on earth will be blessed through you	All who call on name of Jesus will be saved
I will give this land	Jesus prepares a place for us to be with the Father
