- Adhere to the discipline process (see StoneBridge By-Laws Article Fourteen) carried out by the Senior Pastor and leadership of StoneBridge in matters of conduct and doctrine
- Participate in the process of confirming a new Senior Pastor should the occasion arise (for a description of the voting rights of members of StoneBridge Church, please refer to the StoneBridge Church By-Laws Article Seven)

MEMBERS OF STONEBRIDGE CAN EXPECT CHURCH LEADERSHIP TO:

- Pastor them as they seek to be conformed to the image of Jesus (Romans 8:29)
- Equip them for the good works God has created them to do (Ephesians 2:10 & Ephesians 4:11-13)
- Create opportunities for them to worship God in Spirit and Truth (John 4:23)
