The Road of Freedom



- Legalism focus on external behavior and observance of the law to the neglect of the heart of the law
- Antinomianism because we are saved by grace through faith we can live however we want



Acts of the Flesh

- Sexual sins sexual immorality, impurity, debauchery
- Religious sins idolatry, witchcraft
- Interpersonal sins hatred discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions, envy
- Sins of excess drunkenness, orgies





Acts of the Flesh

Out of step with culture

- Sexual immorality any sexual activity outside of marriage
- Drunkenness

Most subtle – idolatry

- Giving worship/allegiance to another that is due to God
 - Base life on anything other than Jesus
 - Give precedence to anything over Jesus
- Tempted to create idols to ease our fears

Destroys the church – hatred, discord, dissensions, factions – all bring needless division; politics is key instigator



Confession of a Legalist

Father, I confess that like the older brother I am a legalist.

I am tempted to reject the freedom You give me and to replace it with the yoke of slavery to the law.

I am tempted to earn both my salvation and Your love through my good works.

I focus on the letter of the law and not the spirit and I am more concerned about my behavior than my heart before You.

Confession of an Antinomian
