### **New Creation**

- **New creation –** result of being born again
- **2Cor 5.17 -** Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!

#### What matters most to God

- Question God is asking us Are you a new creation? Have you been born again?
- Question we ask ourselves Am I trusting Jesus and is that trust being demonstrated through seeking the good of others? (Gal 5.6)



# I've been crucified to the world and the world to me

- World system of values, thinking, and behavior that is opposed to God
- World has been crucified to me world is dead to me; I am not allured by the things the world values or enticed to think/live according to the standards of the world

am dead to the world; I am not seeking
the things the world values or
thinking/acting according to standards
of the world



## **Becoming What We Are**

- Seek to grow in God's love
  - Pray Eph 3.16-19
  - Remember 'to know' is experiential and relational
- Growth in experience of God's love leads to growth in love for God
  - Worship great way to express love and adoration to God and to receive love from Him
- Growth in love for God results in love for the world being 'pushed out' of our hearts
  - If we are focused on God, then we aren't focused on the world
  - Meditate on Phil 4.8
