

The Holy Spirit Anoints us


Anointing –

Physically – to pour oil on the head/smear on the forehead as a sign of consecration to a particular role

Spiritually – to be set apart for certain work by the Father and to be empowered to do that work by the Holy Spirit

Ex 28.30 – Aaron/sons anointed as priests

1Sam 9.16 – Samuel anoints Saul as king **1Kings 19.16** – Elisha anointed to replace Elijah as prophet to Israel

 - Who we are our role in 'building up the body'
