Pentecost

Remember Father and Son giving the Holy Spirit to the Church (Acts 2)

Old Covenant – God dwells in the Temple; 'when Solomon finished praying ... the glory of the Lord filled the temple' (2Chr 7.1.)

New Covenant – God lives in the hearts of His people

1 Cor 3.16: Don't you know that you yourselves (plural) are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in your midst?
1 Cor 6.19: Do you not know that your bodies (singular) are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God?

The Holy Spirit



You Are the Salt of the Earth



Primary function – preservative

Impurities could lessen or negate
effectiveness – cause the salt to 'lose
its saltiness'





The Holy Spirit Refines Us

The Fruit of the Spirit





We are a mixture of 'salt' (fruit of the Spirit) and 'sand' (flesh)



The Holy Spirit Refines Us

Refining – process of removing impurities so the character of Jesus is seen more clearly

Refining takes time – will see change not just in responses, but reactions, over time

Not always pleasant – what is being burned away is deeply embedded in our hearts and way of living

Jesus is the standard – be perfect as your Heavenly Father is perfect

Perfect – mature and complete in love; see this lived out most clearly in Jesus



You Are the Light of the World



Primary function – illuminates; allows us to see things more clearly Hiding a light undermines its core function

Apart from anointing of the Holy Spirit our light does not help people see Father very clearly

The Gifts of the Spirit



Empowerment is rarely overwhelming – God is always looking for trust
