Helpful things to know:

- •Sickness and sin: In their worldview, sin was directly linked to suffering and affliction. Our world is afflicted by sin, impacting us all.
- •Son of Man: Jesus refers to himself, pointing to Daniel 7, where the Son of Man is given divine authority.

Daniel 7: 13-14

13 "In my vision at night I looked, and there before me was one like a **son of man**, coming with the clouds of heaven. He approached the Ancient of Days and was led into his presence. 14 He was given authority, glory and sovereign power; all nations and peoples of every language worshiped him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion that will not pass away, and his kingdom is one that will never be destroyed.





Visible reveals the invisible:

- •The deeds of the men --- the faith of the men
- •The paralysis of the man --- the sin of the man
- •Jesus audibly address the scribes --- the evil in their hearts
- •The healing of the paralytic --- Jesus' divine nature and authority to forgive sins





2 Corinthians 4:18

So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.

Jesus is focused on the invisible/eternal:

- His eternal kingdom
- Our eternal souls

The heart/soul

- •Denotes the centre of all physical and spiritual life
- The centre and seat of spiritual life
 - The soul or mind, as it is the fountain and seat of the thoughts, passions, desires, appetites, affections, purposes, endeavors





The GOOD NEWS

- •Jesus came not only to take the consequences of our sin (the symptoms of sin)
 - Divine DayQuil
- •Jesus came to make us healthy (heal our souls)

Hebrews 10:14

For by one sacrifice he has made perfect forever those who are being made holy.

•By his grace we are saved and being saved.

We must participate with God in the formation of our souls.
