Jesus is Messiah

• **Isa 35.5-6:** Then will the eyes of the blind be opened and the ears of the deaf unstopped. Then will the lame leap like a deer, and the mute tongue shout for joy.

• **Isa 61.1:** The Spirit of the Sovereign LORD is on me, because the LORD has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor.

•**Mt 11.12** - From the days of John the Baptist until now, the kingdom of heaven has been subjected to violence, and violent people have been raiding it.

•**Lk 16.16** - The Law and the Prophets were proclaimed until John. Since that time, the good news of the kingdom of God is being preached, and everyone is forcing their way into it.

When Disappointed With Jesus
