What we see about Jesus

Authority – power over sources of suffering

- Death sees death as temporary condition (sleep) vs permanent state
- Sickness chronic and incurable
- **Demons** impossible to deny

Compassion – to be deeply moved by the suffering of others, always prompts Jesus to action

Openness to everyone – responds to: Upright man An unclean and isolated woman

What Jesus expects from us

Faith – trust in Him to heal/deliver Mustard seed – doesn't take much; emphasis on His willingness to work According to your faith = in response to your faith, not in proportion to your faith

Boldness –

Shameless audacity – Lk 11.5-8;

combination of persistence and disregard for what others think

Note – all 4 are desperate; can't manufacture desperation

Recognition of His identity – Son of David is Messianic title
