Matthew 5-9 – demonstrates Jesus is the Messiah by highlighting His authority:


- The right to do something, i.e. teach about the Kingdom of God

## Sending Out Workers/Shepherds:

Who is sent – the 12 Apostles

Where are they sent – to the Jews

Why are they sent – Jesus has compassion for the crowds because they are harassed and helpless like sheep without a shepherd

What are they sent to do – continue Jesus' ministry of proclaiming the Kingdom, healing diseases, casting out demons, raising the dead

**How are they sent –** in the authority of Jesus; trusting in God to provide
