Rooted in the Lord's Prayer - Your Kingdom come, Your will be done on earth (our community) as it is in heaven

Four anchors keep us tethered/tied to this prayer of Jesus



ANCHORS

Deep Roots

- •Being conformed into the image of Jesus (Rom 8.29)
- •Being led by the Spirit (Gal 5.25)

Broad Branches

- •Doing the good works God has created for us to do (Eph 2.10)
- •Being a blessing in the place where God has planted us (Jer 29.4-7)





FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT

Gentle/Gentleness

- •Not weakness or softness; strength under control, power harnessed in love for and service to others
- •One who is gentle will not attempt to push others around or impose their will on others
- •A smoldering wick He did not snuff out, a bruised reed He did not break

Humble/Humility

- •Like the tax collector to see ourselves correctly; recognizing our sinfulness/need for grace (Lk 18.9-14)
- •Like a child to trust God complete; be utterly dependent upon the Lord for all our needs (Mt 18.1-4)



Cultivate Gentleness & Humility

- •Both ask; ultimately a work of God in our hearts
- Humility acknowledge specific areas of need before the Lord
- Gentleness put yourself in the shoes of others (empathy)



Being Led by the Spirit

- •Direct questions God, should I __?
 - Ask
 - Listen
 - Obey
- •Sensitivity to the Spirit promptings over the course of the day
 - Ask give me eyes to see/ears to hear You today
 - Awareness pay attention to the internal voice
 - Step out test the voice
