Jer 33.14-16

- Messiah will be descendant of David (a king)
- He will do what is just (conforming to the Law) and right (conforming to the nature/will of God)
- Results of His reign will be His people:
 - Being saved (delivered)
 - Living in safety (free form harm/danger)
 - Taking on His name (The Lord our Righteous Savior)
- Our response as we look for God to work is to qawe (kavay) – encompasses waiting, trusting and hoping



Who is the Messiah?

- The Messenger of the Covenant
 - Matt 26.28 This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.
- The One you seek/the One you desire/the God of Justice
 - See more clearly at Jesus' 2nd coming (Rev 19-20)
 - At 1st coming– Jesus invites people to repent and follow Him in order to be forgiven and avoid punishment for sin



What will the Messiah do?

- Come to the Temple (surprisingly)
- He will purify/cleanse the people of God
 - Refiner's fire/lauder's soap both cleanse without destroying the object they are cleansing
 - See Jesus' Cleansing of the Temple in Matt 21.12-17



What will be the results of the Messiah's activity?

- No one will be able to stand before Him all are in need of cleansing; see Prodigal Son in Luke 15.12-32
- People of God will worship in ways that are acceptable to the Lord
 - Heb 10.10 And by that will, we have been made holy through the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ once for all
 - 1Cor 6.11 But you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God



Our response to the Messiah's coming

- To submit/embrace the refining process through:
 - Repentance a change of mind leading to a change in behavior
 - Bringing acceptable sacrifices to God
 - Rom 12.1 Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship.
