Matthew Recap

- Stumbling block that which could cause another to fall off the right path; refers to sin and can refer to offense as well; a tripping hazard
- Serious business better to have millstone tied around neck and be thrown into sea than to be a stumbling block to another
- Deal with decisively cut off hand, gouge out eye if they cause you to stumble





1Pet 4.8 - Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins.

Love deeply – root idea is tension or strain; in this case it is to earnestly love, to not slack off in love, to love at full force/strength

Covers over – literally hides; forgives/overlooks sins of others vs prolonging a dispute/conflict; see Proverbs 10.12 - Hatred stirs up conflict, but love covers over all wrongs.

Reconciling with someone who has sinned against you-

Step 1: Go to the person

Point out – uncover

Win – gain; gain back a relationship vs losing one

Step 2: Bring 1 or 2 witnesses


Confirm sin has been committed Urge repentance

Step 3: Bring before the body

Same as step 2
You (singular) can step out of the relationship if no repentance from the other
