# Jesus as Four Stones

**Rejected stone** – stone that was inspected by a mason and then set aside as being unfit for the task

**Cornerstone** - first stone laid in a foundation with which all other stones are aligned

**Capstone** – last stone placed in an arch that holds the arch together and allows it to bear weight

**Stumbling stone** – stone on the path that is tripped over

- Are you rejecting Him?
  - **Passively** – haven't thought much about Him; ask Him to reveal Himself to you
  - **Actively** – often rooted in pain or disappointment; would you bring that to God?
