- Withdrawal you will not see Me again until ...



- False Messiahs people claiming to be sent by God as deliverers
- International hostility and conflict
- Natural disasters

Birth pains experienced by the Church

- Persecution
- False prophets/deception
- Turning away from Jesus
- Gospel to the nations

MATTHEW 24:1-14



Two explicit commands:

Watch out that no one deceives you

 Best protection against deception is knowing the Truth (Jesus)

See to it that you do not become alarmed (frightened)

- Jesus promises to never leave us or forsake us
- Our Father is:
 - All-wise
 - All-powerful
 - All-good

Two implicit commands

Stand firm – endure in face of opposition/difficulty
