- Temple will be destroyed before disciples' generation dies out (24.34)
- No sign of Jesus' return (24.30)
 - Timing unknown (24.36)
 - Nature unexpected (24.44)
- We are to keep watch (24.42) and be ready (24.44)
 - Be wise (25.1-13) live according to the truth we have received
 - Be faithful (25.14-30) be good stewards of all we've been given





Judgment- process where God calls people to account for the way they lived their lives and assigns their eternal destiny accordingly



Sheep – the blessed, the righteous Receive eternal life which is described as the 'kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world'

Rev 21-22-

- God will be our God and we will be His people
- Holy City (21.9-27) and a Garden (22.1-5)
- No more death or mourning or crying or pain; no more curse
- The old order will pass away and all things will be made new



Goats - the cursed, the wicked

- Receive eternal punishment described as 'the lake of fire created for the devil and his angels'
- Eternal punishment doesn't mean eternal torture but eternity separated from God and *all* that is good
- If heaven is 'I will be their God and they will be My people,' then hell is 'I won't be their God and they won't be My people'



Who are the 'least of these brothers and sisters of Mine?'

Christians who are suffering-

- Least of these 'little ones' always refers to disciples (Mt10.42, 18.6, 18.10, 18.14)
- Brothers/sisters always refers to disciples except when referring to siblings
- We do have responsibility to care for any who are suffering -
 - Good Samarian question is not
 'who is my neighbor' but 'to
 whom am I a neighbor?'



What is the basis of judgment?

- Our works? 'for I was hungry and you gave Me something to eat...'
- His grace/our faith? for it is by grace you have been saved through faith...not of works (Eph 2.8-9)
- John 6.29 the work of God is this: to believe in the One He has sent
- Belief = trust and trust is always expressed through action
- Rev 20.11-15; name written in Book of Life
