#### Conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the Gospel

- Ch 2 have same mindset as Jesus
  - Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit; in humility value others above yourself; look not to your own interests but to interests of others
- Ch 3 have same mindset as Paul
  - Put no confidence in the flesh
    - Righteousness conformity to a standard (meeting God's expectations)
    - Righteous right standing before God (right relationship with God)
    - We are righteous (in right relationship with the Lord) because of our righteousness (meeting God's expectations of us)
  - Two grounds for righteousness
    - Our flesh/work our achievements, accomplishments, pedigree
    - **Jesus** we trust in Him and His conformity to God's standards is applied to us



# Description of Paul's mindset – highest value/greatest desire

I want to know Christ – personal and experiential

- Knowing the power of His resurrection power that raised Jesus from the dead is also at work in our lives (Eph 1.19-20)
- Participating in His sufferings koinonia; our suffering for Jesus is a partnership w/Him in His sufferings for us/others
- **Becoming like Him in death** being conformed into His image; see 2.6-11 taking posture of slave, using what He has been given for sake of others, walking in humility
- Attaining the resurrection of the dead future state



Description of Paul's mindset – already running the race, but not yet crossed finish line

Not that I have already obtained all this or reached the goal but I press on...

• Already but not yet dynamic of the Christian life – we can experience rule/reign of God right now and we will continue to struggle with the results of the fall, activity of the devil, and consequences of sin until Jesus returns

### **Athletic metaphor –** runner running a race

- forgetting what is behind all the things from v4-7 that Paul could formerly see as basis for right standing w/God
- **straining** to exert oneself to the uttermost
- press on to move rapidly and decisively towards an object

To take hold of that for which Christ took hold of me – relationship w/Him; this is the 'prize for which God has called us heavenward'

• Core desire of God – to form a people for Himself



## **Command to Adopt Paul's Mindset**

Take such a view – have same mindset as Paul

- Trusting in righteousness of Jesus
- Desiring to know Jesus
- Realizing we haven't arrived yet

**Live up to what we have already attained –** be faithful with what we have been given

- Live in light of the truth we have received in Gospel
- Live in light of the power we have received through the Spirit




# **Command to Adopt Paul's Mindset**

Follow godly examples because there are some who live as enemies of cross of Christ:

- Message of the cross that we needed saving; that our righteousness isn't sufficient basis to be declared righteous
- Destiny is destruction hell
- Their god is their stomach driven by appetites of the flesh
- Their glory is their shame what they perceive as honoring themselves actually condemns them
- Their mind is set on earthly things can't follow
  Jesus with 'earthly mindset'

## Our citizenship is in heaven –

- Jesus is our King and He resides in heaven therefore our citizenship is in heaven as well
- He will come back from heaven and finish the work He started



#### Cultivate mindset of Paul –

- Is our highest value/greatest desire to know Jesus?
  - Fundamental is salvation more a means to avoid hell or more a means to be reconciled to God?
- Are we living up to what we have already attained?
  - NT truth use it or lose it (parable of talents)
  - Are we walking in the truth we have received?
  - Are we walking in the power we have received?
- Are we living as citizens of heaven?
  - Not easy to live in this world while maintaining a heavenly mindset
