**Doctrine of Incarnation** - Jesus is both 100% God and 100% human

**Who Jesus is (ch 1) -**

- Will inherit all that has been made
- All things were made through Him
- Radiance of God's glory and exact representation of His being
- Sustains all things by His word
- Death provides for purification of our sins
- Seated at right hand of God






# HEBREWS RECAP

## Who Jesus is (ch 2) -

- Made a little lower than the angels for a little while
- Pioneer of our salvation
- Our brother
- Renders devil powerless
- Delivers us from the fear of death
- Merciful and faithful High Priest who makes atonement for us (brings us into right relationship with God)
- Helps us when we are tempted

**One command** – pay most careful attention to message of Jesus





# HEBREWS

## 3:1-6

Therefore, holy brothers and sisters, who share in the heavenly calling, fix your thoughts on Jesus, whom we acknowledge as our apostle and high priest.

- Fix your thoughts – continually devote your attention to
- Acknowledge – confess; pledge loyalty and allegiance
- Apostle – sent one; a person given an assignment/task to accomplish
- High priest – represents people to the Lord, particularly on Day of Atonement



# HEBREWS 3:1-6

## Moses was faithful as servant in God's house

- Servant – given responsibility; unusual word that signifies an honorable and dignified office; speaks of one who provides devoted service freely offered, speaks to relationship between servant and one served
- God's house – physical structure; tabernacle (replaced by Temple); place where God dwelled and people met Him
- Moses was given
  - Blueprints for tabernacle
  - Instructions for worship – offerings, sacrifices, holy days





# HEBREWS 3:1-6

## Jesus is faithful as Son over God's house

- Son –given authority; all is built by/through Him, He will inherit all
- God's house – spiritual structure; He now dwells within His people (individually and corporately)
- Through His death, Jesus
  - Renders physical Temple obsolete
  - Offers a better sacrifice
  - Establishes Himself as Cornerstone of New Temple
  - Builds this New Temple with living stones
