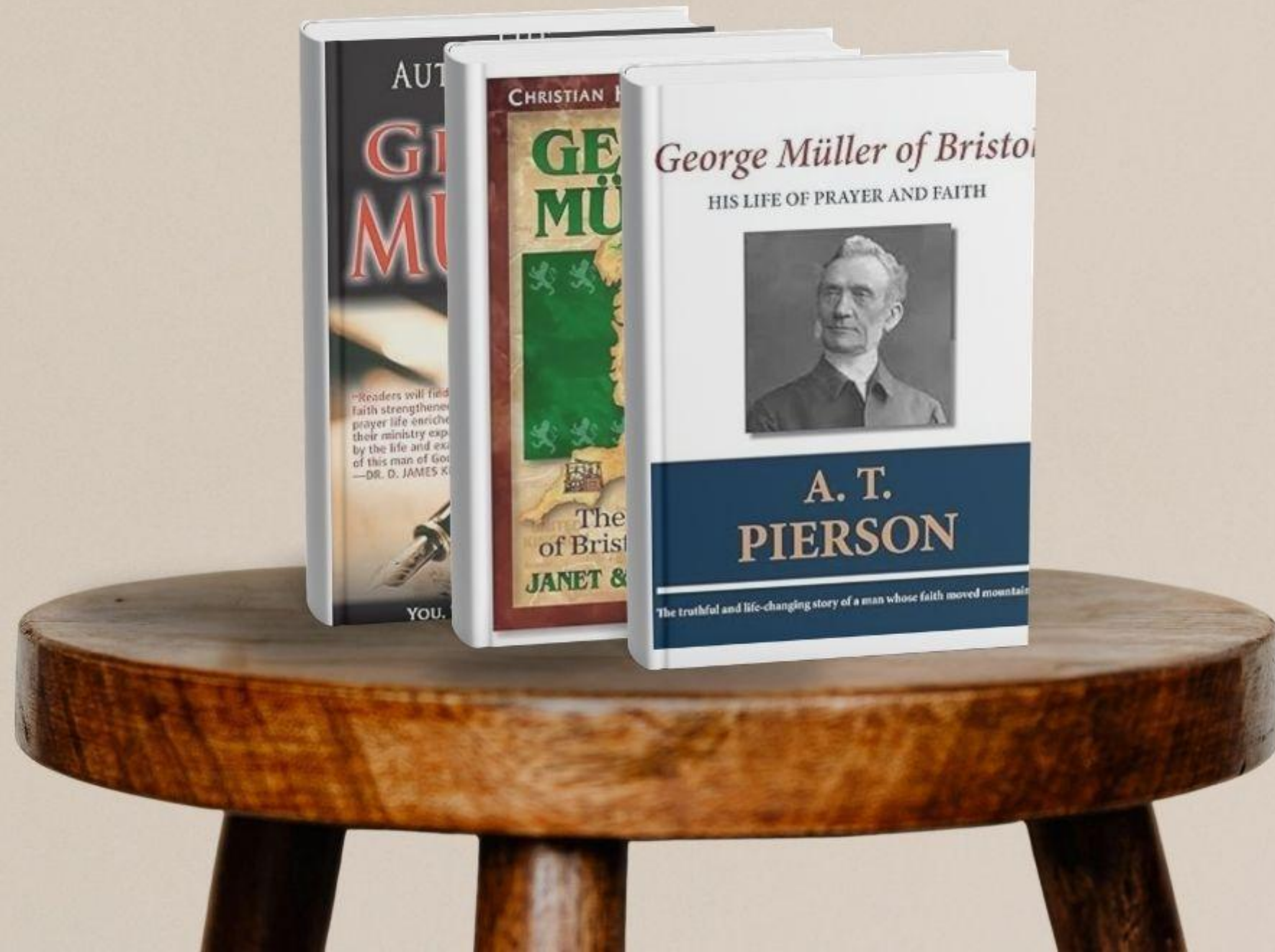

ICEBREAKER QUESTIONS

- Do you have a favorite family tradition?
- What is the best gift you've ever received?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Any overall impressions from the book?
- What impacted you the most as you read the book – both encouragement and challenge?
Specifically, Muller said his aim was to demonstrate that God could be trusted with daily needs/what could be accomplished through prayer and faith. How does his example challenge/encourage you?
- Do you have an experience of trusting the Lord for others (bringing a ‘paralytic’ to Jesus or believing God to meet needs of another)? How did it go? How was your faith impacted?
- **Answer based on life station (retired or still working)**
How do you think of service/mission/calling over time? How do you picture spending your retirement years? Are there obstacles to engaging in ministry you currently experience/foresee?



RESPONSE

Pray together (no one has to pray out loud)

If you do pray out loud – keep it short

Faith – always expressed; sometimes:

- **More outward expression** –

- Is the Lord asking you to take an outward step of obedience in this season? Is there a ‘yes, but’ involved on your end?

- **More inward expression** –

- Is the Lord asking you to wait on Him to do something He has said He would do?

- **Intercession** – praying for mercy for the places God has planted you

*Praise that both cottages at The 3:20 fully funded. Please pray that we will get the necessary permits ASAP so that we can begin construction.

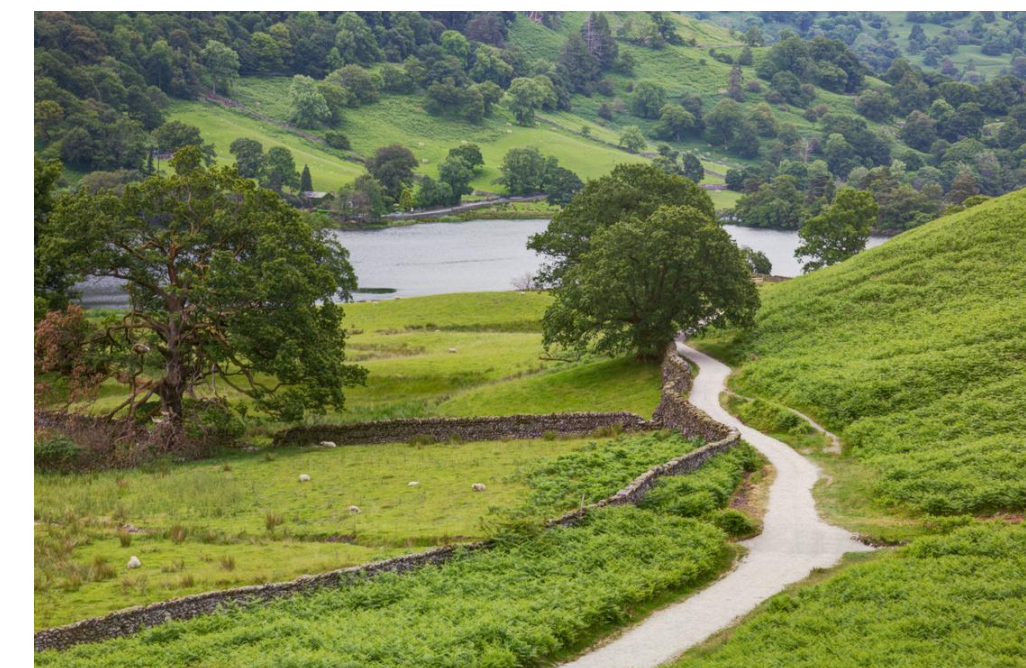
*Please pray for wisdom in decision making (daily, short-term, and long-term) and compassion when responding to both our friends and volunteers.

ENGLAND



England is the most secular of the four countries that comprise the UK. The steady decline in belief and church attendance is of deep concern. Only 6% of people regularly attend church; those who do attend rarely engage with the unbelieving majority. Notional Christianity is giving way to atheism as the main barrier to true faith; the trappings of inherited cultural forms of Christianity are being discarded. This presents both a great challenge and a new opportunity for a fresh start to the re-evangelization of England. Pray that the Holy Spirit may break into lives and bring a sense of the reality of God and the truth of the gospel.
