- Abel's willingness to trust God led him to be called righteous.

Abraham

- Leave everything familiar and follow God to a land He will reveal.
- Trust that God will give you what He has promised, even before you possess it.
- Believe that God will give you a son when humanly speaking it is impossible.
- Trust that through this son God will raise up a great nation and bless the world.
- Surrender even the promised son, believing that God's purposes cannot fail.





HEBREWS 11:4-22

Live in a tent-

- Live with purpose (Do your deal)
- Live with impact
- Live heavenly minded
- Fix our eyes on the unseen promises of God.
