Moses' Parents

- They refused to surrender to fear.
- They believed God had a purpose greater than Pharoah's decree

Faith

- Refuses to let fear make decisions
- Acknowledges that God's purposes are greater than the threats around us.

 - The wealth of Egypt
 - The prestige of being a prince
 - The pleasures of sin

- Moses embraced
 - Identification with God's people.
 - Abuse and suffering
 - God's promise

Moses Connection to Jesus

- Moses identified with God's people.
- Jesus identifies with us.
- Moses accepted abuse for God's people.
- Jesus endured the cross for the joy set before Him.
